BBBSWE is currently seeking to fill a multiple positions on their Board of Directors. Board members are responsible for strategic oversight of BBBSWE operations and ensuring sustainability and excellence in service. Specific duties will include, but are not limited to: policy administration; evaluation of Agency operations against standards of performance; representing BBBSWE in the community and at Agency events; selection and evaluation of the Executive Director of the Agency; approving and monitoring the corporate finances of the Agency. The term of each Board Member is 3 years, with an estimated commitment of approximately 6 hours per month. Each board member is required to sit on at least one sub-committee of the Board of Directors.
